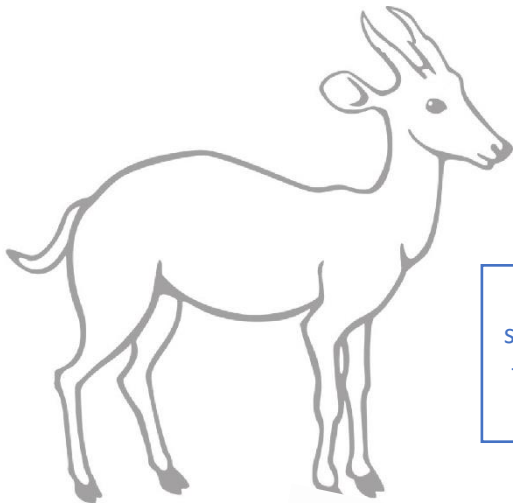
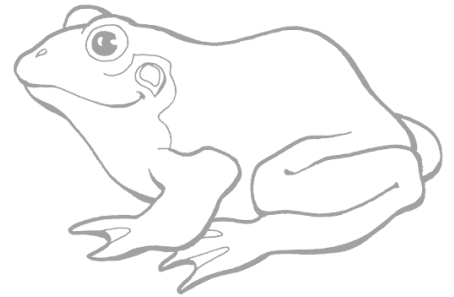


Puffins have brightly coloured beaks, look a little bit like penguins and like to eat small fish.

Frogs come in lots of different colours including green, grey, brown and sometimes yellow.

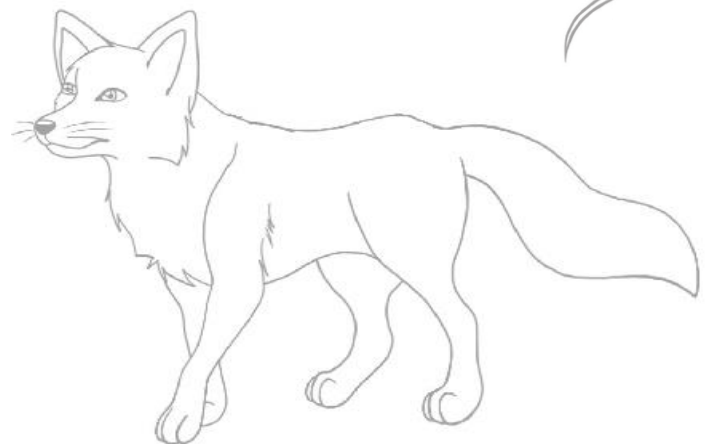


Muntjac deer are the smallest type of deer in the UK and are mostly seen at dusk.

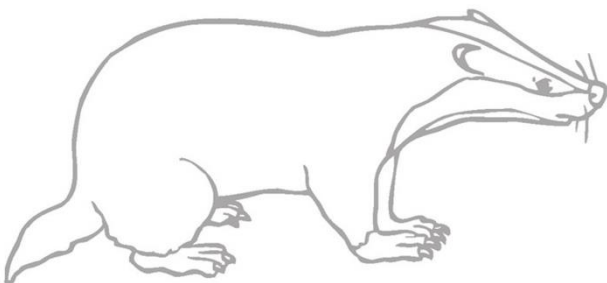
The Harvest mouse is the smallest rodent in Europe. They like to eat seeds, corn and insects.
